


Tracy & Karen




### Fun facts about us

why we are choosing Adoption

We struggled with infertility and pregnancy loss for two years before Karen was diagnosed with breast cancer. We paused Karen's cancer treatment when she was first diagnosed, so that she could do IVF and freeze her eggs before starting chemotherapy. Two years later, when Karen was healthy again, she went through the rest of the IVF process, with the hopes of conceiving with our two created embryos. Sadly, those efforts didn't work and the harsh chemo treatments made it impossible to try again.

We spent time grieving that loss, but after many months we decided together that we still very much wanted to be parents, and we were excited to begin the adoption process! It's been a long and difficult journey to parenthood, but we continue to believe that the child that is meant to be in our life will come.

She found that the hot & cold could coexist. She could hold sadness and hope, joy and frustration and potential and heartache all together.

This quote really speaks to us and the struggles we have faced over the past several years with infertility and cancer. Although your situation is different, we think these words may possibly speak to what you are feeling today, and what you may feel if you choose an adoption plan for your child.
